








Budget WORKSHEET

Now that you have an idea of what and where you would like your wedding to happen, it's time to get down to the nitty gritty:

TIPS AND ADVICE

Julia & Adam say:

Firstly, start an excel sheet or a cost app, it will help you getting a feel foo costs and budget. When booking with us, we have a venue hire (various options) and then a beverage package price per head, that gives you the flexibility for an intimate wedding or a larger guest list and us the chance for a superb service on the day with loads of staff looking after you and your guests.

Write down your dreams & ideas. From those, find that specific one that is not negotiable. With the other ideas, you might be able to have some wriggle room.

Once you have locked in your venue, we suggest locking in celebrant and photographer next, then catering (will will be the higher expenses), music and stylist/florist, these suppliers might not be able to do 2 events on one day, so best to have them sorted out early. If you are looking for that specific amazing service provider, then they are worth their price. But you could consider swopping the cake, the fancy car or the 2nd dress to be able to have that supplier or service on the day.

Always ask for the extra costs, so there are no hidden surprise on the day. Booking a vendor whom you trust is important that way, which ideally will always be forthcoming with all the details and costs.





TIPS AND ADVICE

Agi says:

Setting a realistic budget is going to be the first step to work on when you start your wedding planning process.

If you know that there is a specific venue, or a vendor you would like to work with, it's best to reach out to them, and get some pricing first, to be able to determine how much your overall budget will be.

It's also great to make a list of all the things that are important to you, for example, having a band vs a Dj, or having signature cocktails vs beer and wine packages. There might be some significant cost difference depending on the vibe you are going for.

The location will also be a huge factor in your budget. If you are planning to get married in the country, and you can find all of your suppliers nearby, that's fantastic. But if they have to travel from the city, and stay the night, unfortunately you will have to factor in travel and accommodation costs for all of those yendors.

We are all about supporting local businesses, and they will also be able to recommend their favourite people too.





THE PLANNER'S GUIDE

STEP BY STEP PLANNING

Agi from @wholelottalovecreative knows quite a lotta about planning and coordinating events, heck, she's a pro at it. Here's how she says to plan a wedding:

- Make a guest list and set your budget
- Start looking at venues and engage with a caterer if your venue doesn't provide food
- If you need help with finding the right venue and suppliers, this is the time to look for a wedding planner
- Choose your wedding photographer and videographer, or any MUST HAVE vendors
- Choose your wedding party
- Think about the overall vibe and how you would like to achieve it (having a band vs DJ, going bright or having a moody set up)
- Book your DJ or Band and Celebrant
- Dress shopping
- Send out invitations
- Book a stylist (or if you aren't having one, engage with a florist and book linen, furniture, lighting and other decor items)
- Book hair and makeup artists

- Order wedding bands
- Wedding party outfits
- Hair and makeup trial
- Book a cake maker
- Finalize menu
- Write your vows

- Organize wedding party gifts and favours f you are planning to have them
- Dress fitting
- Finalize your guest lists and chosen songs
- Organize all final payments
- Finalize on the day timeline and seating plan
- Order on the day stationery
- Go through event order with your venue manager
- Finalize all small items such as napkins, table arrangements etc



These milestones are just for reference only, based on common practice. But of course, this is NOT the only way of doing things.

If you decide to elope, or rush down to the registry office, the steps will be different.

The most important thing is: for whatever you really want to do/have, plan ahead as soon as you can to avoid any heartaches,



What about the wedding mindset?

'Seen in the In Between' is a private membership space on Patreon created by me, Evie Wilson. I have been a Marriage Celebrant for 5 years and a Mindset Coach for 1.5 years and I noticed that there's so much more to wedding planning than just inviting guests and choosing an outfit.

There's so much mindset stuff that goes on behind the scenes and no one who specifically works with that area. And so now, I've named myself a Marriage Coach and I've created this online membership space to give you what is currently not offered anywhere else.

So are you wondering how something like this fits into your wedding planning? It sits right in there alongside (for example) the penis straws at your Hen's Party. It goes hand in hand. The lead up to the beginning of your marriage is complex, as we all are as people, so let's still have it all. And this space will be the new rite of passage to add to your journey.

In this space, I am your coach. I may also be your celebrant, but I don't have to be.

So what will we speak about in here? All of it all.

The overwhelm + stress of planning a wedding while life is still rolling on, about having difficult conversations with loved ones about what you *really* want, about setting clear boundaries, having feminist type conversations and bringing marriage into 2022 - will you change your name? for example. How you're feeling about marriage? how's this new life stage feeling for you?

Each month will be a different mix of Q+A sessions, input from other incredible people, discussion topics plus more. More than likely no two months will be the same as I create + hold the space you need.

The Patreon page is a month by month membership, and you can stay as long as you need. Whether it's 3 months, 6 months, 12 or 24 months, you can simply cancel your membership once you've had your incredible wedding day and you're married.

FROM THE PROS

It's all about connection

Hire vendors that you connect with., who will be able to see your vision and most of all understand it. Trusting your vendors will take away 90% of the stress

Carry bobby pins

Yes, just like McGiver. If you have Morgane by your side, she'll have your back. But just in case, grab a couple and keep 'em close

Take time for each other

It's your wedding. It's about you. You don't have to impress anyone, just enjoy what is happening with your loved ones, there's nothing else you have to do

Delegate the boring stuff

You may or may not have an entourage with you, regardless, don't hesitate to throw the stuff you don't want to deal with to your vendors, mum, mates...

Be thankful

you would be surprised how a 'thank you' to the people involved at your wedding (vendors!) goes a LONG way. We notice it, and we don't forget it. This little gem of appreciation will go a long way (and even get you bonus prints, goodies!)

Don't worry about being late

Everyone who is coming to your wedding have nothing else planned. So take your time, and don't worry if you need an extra 40mins to fix up your hair

Don't worry about being late

Eat your lunch!

You don't want to pass out halfway during the ceremony. We know the nerve might prevent you from hunger, but trust us, a couple of nuts and watermelon will do you wonders

Find the scissors

You would not believe the time we spend looking for scissors to cut out tag of suits on the wedding day. Be prepared, locate the scissors

affirmations

Stretch out and set

Before you get out of bed, what about trying to stretch out nicely, and set positive affirmations for your day. If you need guidance, check out @stylebydeni 's daily affirmations



REAL LIFE MARRIED COUPLES SHARE THEIR

#1ADVICE

Jess says

Make sure your plan for a wet-weather option and be flexible with your plans. I got married in the rain and was soaked!



Jade says

Communicate with your vendors. Don't wait for them to contact you if you have a question

Jesse says

Explains your vision and plans to your venue. We ended up being very restricted in our plans because the venue wasn't open to what we wanted to do, but we didn't realise



The big bad C* word had us postponing our wedding 3 times. Try to go in without too many expectations, apart from expecting Covid 19 to have somewhat an impact



Danielle says

Wear the dress! Don't worry about the train or the bottom getting wet or dirty, the next day it won't matter. What matters are the moments.

Scott says

Research your venue options. Turns out, theere are plenty of different ones we didn't know about that would have matched us better. We're renewing our vows there ;)

Tim says

Don't go into debt or borrow money to have your wedding. Maybe hold off until you've saved up enough, or really stick to your priorities

Amy and Josh say

Don't get blind drunk. If you like to party, organise a fiesta the week before to get it out of your system, because you will want to be bright and sharp on your wedidng day (and remember it!)

Ash says

It goes so fast! So make sure you don't over burden yourself with extra things to do on the day



Emily says

Don't invite people just out of politeness. Streamlining your guest list will actually help avoid potential problems on the day

WORST EXPERIENCE

AT WEDDINGS

Claire says

Not having food options for vegetarians or restricted diets (I ended up only eating a handful of walnuts!)

QUICK TIP

Of course, you won't be able to plan for everyone's intolerances and diet restrictions, BUT a good caterer will suggest adding a vegan option (which also works for a variety of other diets). Speak to the caterers to get the best info

Amanda says

The couple insisted on having the ceremony outside, in pouring rain.

All I could think about was how cold my feet were...

QUICK TIP

Always have a wet/cold weather option. Or if you really want to have your ceremony at a specific spot, be flexible on the times, or maybe plan to read your vows there intimately



The no-phone policy is great, but it made me inadvertently looking for people breaching the rule and making me the phone police!

QUICK TIP

An easy fix for this would be to announce the no phone policy during the ceremony only, to ensure everyone is fully present. In most cases, people will then leave their phones in their pockets and forget about updating their snapchats.

Precíous says

Having to look for transport between ceremony and reception

QUICK TIP

If your ceremony differs from the reception venue, you could check for transport options available, and mention this on the invites; or better yet, organise transport yourselves with a bus

Jessica says

Awkward ambiance. People not mingling

QUICK TIP

Having a great celebrant will set out the ambiance for the rest of the festivities. If are worried for after, most of them also offer to MC so it's a nice continuation.

Also, pick a good music band
